Owner Share 32 of SAD in the amount of \$207,817 33 34 WHEREAS, The ADEC advised that in order to receive the maximum amount of the 35 Principal Forgiveness subsidy, which has been allocated to this project (\$122,822) we need to 36 show a Loan Application amount of \$277,090; and 37 38 WHEREAS, The Council needs to pass a new resolution authorizing a loan application 39 amount of \$277,090 to receive the maximum benefit of the Principal Forgiveness subsidy; and 40 WHEREAS, The net effect of the Principal Forgiveness subsidy is that the updated Total 41 Project Costs, to be shared between the City and the property owners, is \$199,852. 42
