A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE  
2022-2027 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN AND ESTABLISHING  
CAPITAL PROJECT LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR  
2023.

WHEREAS, Duly published hearings were held on September 13 and September 27, 2021 to introduce the final draft of the 2022-2027 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and to obtain public comments on capital improvement projects and legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, The Council received comments from all of the City of Homer Advisory Board and Commissions and held a Special Meeting on August 23, 2021; and

WHEREAS, It is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor, the State Legislature, State agencies, the Alaska Congressional Delegation, and other potential funding sources with adequate information regarding the City's capital project funding needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer, Alaska, that the "City of Homer Capital Improvement Plan 2022-2027" is hereby adopted as the official 6-year capital improvement plan for the City of Homer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following capital improvement projects are identified as priorities for the FY2023 State Legislative Request:

1. Port of Homer: New Large Vessel Harbor
2. Multi-Use Community Center
3. Slope Stability Project
4. Homer Barge Mooring and Large Vessel Haul Out Facility
5. Homer Spit Coastal Erosion Mitigation

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that projects for the FY2023 Federal Legislative Request will be:

1. Port of Homer: New Large Vessel Harbor
2. Multi-Use Community Center

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise appropriate State and Federal representatives and personnel of the City's FY 2023 capital project priorities and take appropriate steps to provide necessary background information.



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
