1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 **ORDINANCE 21-64** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA 7 ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN FY 2021 STATE HOMELAND 8 SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$142,132 FOR A 9 BI-DIRECTIONAL AMPLIFIER SYSTEM FOR HOMER POLICE 10 DEPARTMENT AND MICROWAVE LINKS FOR HOMER'S 11 REPEATERS. 12 13 WHEREAS, The Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management 14 (DHS&EM) makes funds available to strengthen a City's ability to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from all hazard events; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, Effective emergency response operations are dependent on the delivery of 18 timely communications; and 19 WHEREAS, The City recently became aware of two vulnerabilities in the City's 20 emergency response communications systems that compromise delivery of timely 21 22 communications, namely: 23 • Very low radio signal strength within the new Homer Police Department building, which jeopardizes officer and public safety if personnel are unable 24 to pick up radio traffic when inside the building; and 25 26 The one existing microwave link to one of Homer's repeater sites has insufficient capabilities to carry radio control, data, video and voice traffic 27 for Homer Police Department and the other repeater site lacks a microwave 28 29 link; and 30 WHEREAS, Purchasing and installing a bi-directional amplifier system in the Homer 31 Police Department will strengthen signals to allow reliable communication between portable 32 radios inside the building and the ALMR sites outside the building; and 33 34 WHEREAS, Purchasing and installing microwave links and IP radio gateways at two of 35 Homer's repeater sites provides necessary communications capability and backup; and 36 37 WHEREAS, The City is pleased to have been awarded \$142,132 from the DHS&EM to 38 purchase and install a Bi-directional amplifier system at the Police Department and microwave 39 links for Homer's repeaters. 40 41 42 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:
