8	AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY AND ACCEPT A LOAN
9	FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
10	CONSERVATION, ALASKA DRINKING WATER FUND, IN AN
11	AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$86,250 TO FINANCE COSTS OF THE
12	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT'S COMPUTERIZED MAINTENANCE
13	MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (CMMS).

15	WHEREAS, The Homer City Council adopted Resolution 21-062 and Resolution 21-063
16	awarding contracts to Antero and HDR respectively, for products/services to update the Public
17	Works Department's Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS); and
18	WILEDEAS The Alcele Department of Environmental Concernation (ADES) has accorded
19 20	WHEREAS, The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has awarded the City a Principal Forgiveness Subsidy in the amount of \$75,000 to be applied for Sustainable
21	Infrastructure Planning Projects (SIPP), such as the CMMS; and
22	minastructure riamming riojects (Sirr), such as the CMMS, and
23	WHEREAS, The pathway for receiving this Subsidy runs through a loan from the ADEC's
24	Drinking Water State Revolving Fund; that is, the City needs to apply for the loan, acquire the
25	product/services, pay for them, apply for reimbursement from the loan and at that time, the
26	Principle Forgiveness Subsidy is applied by the ADEC; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Since the total cost of the CMMS project is \$86,250 and the Principle
29	Forgiveness Subsidy will cover \$75,000, the remaining \$11,250 will be divided between the
30	HART Road Fund, the Water Capital Asset Repair and Maintenance Allowance (CARMA) Fund,
31	and the Sewer CARMA Fund, as originally scheduled.
32	
33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska authorizes
34	the City Manager to apply for, and accept, a loan from the State of Alaska Department of
35	Environmental Conservation's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, in an amount not to
36	exceed \$86,250, for purposes of paying for the costs of the Public Works' CMMS.
