CITY OF HOMER 1 HOMER, ALASKA 2 Aderhold 3 **RESOLUTION 21-081** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER ALASKA 6 ESTABLISHING A REGULAR QUARTERLY REPORT FROM THE 7 SOUTHERN KENAI PENINSULA OPIOID TASK FORCE/ALL THINGS 8 9 ADDICTION ON THE SOUTHERN KENAI PENINSULA TO THE 10 HOMER CITY COUNCIL FOR 2022. 11 12 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council has taken a strong interest in preventing the spread 13 of the opioid epidemic in Homer starting with quarterly worksessions on the topic in 2016; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Council adopted Resolution 18-002 establishing a regular quarterly report 16 from the Southern Kenai Peninsula (SKP) Opioid Task Force that continued through 2019; and 17 WHEREAS, SKP Opioid Task Force reported to Council quarterly and the reports 18 19 included task force updates, notice of community events and programs available, and 20 testimony from people in recovery and families of those in recovery or who have lost loved ones to overdose; and 21 22 WHEREAS, SPK Opioid Task Force reports were put on hold in 2020 as the City and the 23 24 Task Force focused on navigating the COVID-19 pandemic; and 25 26 WHEREAS, The SKP Opioid Task Force remains active, meeting on a monthly basis with work groups to tackle various actionable areas; and 27 28 WHEREAS, The SKP Opioid Task Force has expanded its focus to include other aspects 29 of addiction and now calls itself All Things Addiction on the SKP; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, Homer continues to suffer impacts from the state wide opioid epidemic and 33 experiences drug related crimes and overdose incidents; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Methamphetamine use, alcoholism, and other forms of addiction also 36 remain prevalent in Homer; and 37 WHEREAS, Reports from the SKP Opioid Task Force/All Things Addiction on the SKP to 38 City Council provide an opportunity for the Council and the community to stay abreast of their 39 40 work and for the Task Force to solicit the assistance of Council when appropriate; and
