SUPPORTING THE CITY MANAGER'S EFFORTS TO PUT THE
RECOMMENDED PRACTICES INTO EFFECT.

WHEREAS, Information technology plays an increasingly fundamental role in society and the functions of government; and

WHEREAS, Recent events in the public and private sectors have demonstrated the critical importance of securing data, information systems and equipment against theft, disruption or destruction; and

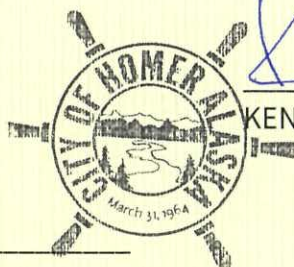
WHEREAS, The City of Homer has a legal duty to protect its systems in the interest of public welfare; and

WHEREAS, The National Institute of Standards and Technology has created the *Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity*, which offers guidance and instruction on security matters, particularly for municipal entities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby endorses the cybersecurity framework created by the National Institute of Standards and Technology, and endorses the City Manager's efforts to put the recommended practices into effect.
