1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA City Manager 3 4 **RESOLUTION 22-034** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 APPROVING A RECREATIONAL USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOMER AND THE KACHEMAK NORDIC SKI CLUB 8 9 REGARDING THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF NORDIC SKI TRAILS ON CITY OWNED LAND IN THE BAYCREST SKI AREA AND 10 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE 11 THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 12 13 WHEREAS, The Kachemak Nordic Ski Club (KNSC) is a non-profit corporation which has 14 been constructing, maintaining, and operating nordic ski trails on public and private lands for 15 16 many years; and 17 WHEREAS, KNSC maintains a network of trails on public and private lands in the 18 Diamond Creek Watershed known as the Baycrest Ski Trails; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, Some of the trails at the Baycrest complex traverse City owned parcels: 22 173-022-01, T 6S R 14W SEC 9 SEWARD MERIDIAN HM SE1/4 SE1/4 EXCLUDING THE W1/2 23 SW1/4 SE1/4 SE1/4 and 173-032-29, T 6S R 14W SEC 10 SEWARD MERIDIAN HM SE1/4 & 24 25 S1/2 SW1/4 the title to which the City accepted via Ordinance 07-03; and 26 27 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC entered into their first MOA regarding these trails in the winter of 2008 and that agreement has expired; and 28 29 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC entered into their second MOA regarding these trails in 30 the winter of 2013 and that agreement has expired; and 31 32 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC entered into their third MOA regarding these trails in the 33 winter of 2017 and that agreement has expired; and 34 35 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC wish to enter into a new MOA and a draft document was 36 submitted to the City Council for its review at its regular meeting on April 25, 2022; and 37 38 WHEREAS, An MOA between the City and KNSC is in the best interest of the public 39 because it promotes public-private partnerships, saves tax dollars, enhances recreational and 40 41 economic development opportunities, and provides access to public lands for the use and
