7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
8 AWARDED TERM CONTRACTS FOR ENGINEERING,
9 ARCHITECTURAL AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES TO
10 MULTIPLE FIRMS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
11 NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.
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13 WHEREAS, The City's practice for engaging engineering services has been to use a Term
14 Contract methodology, where Term Contracts have been issued to multiple firms, who
15 submitted Proposals in response to a Request for Proposal (RFP); and
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17 WHEREAS, Once Term Contracts were executed and needs for engineering services
18 arose for specific projects, staff negotiated the scope, schedule and budgets for Task Orders
19 for such projects; and
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21 WHEREAS, For the past two years, Task Orders have been presented for City Council
22 approval, in accordance with the City's Procurement Manual; and

24 WHEREAS, The City's current Term Contracts for engineering services expired in April
25 2022; and
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27 WHEREAS, A RFP for new Term Contracts for engineering and architectural services was
28 publicly advertised in early April, 2022 and proposals were received from 16 firms; and

30 WHEREAS, After attempting to evaluate proposals on the basis of the evaluation criteria
31 set forth in the RFP and limit the number of firms to which Term Contracts were awarded, staff
32 concluded it was in the best interests of the City to issue Term Contracts to all proposing firms,
33 preserving the City's right to select firms for particular projects on the basis of methodologies,
34 ideas and personnel proposed for a distinct scope of work, rather than an abstract array of
35 resumes.

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, awards Term
38 Contracts for professional services to the following firms and authorizes the City Manager to
39 negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.

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
