1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 **ORDINANCE 22-39** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 APPROPRIATING \$125,000 FROM THE FY23 CAPITAL BUDGET 8 GENERAL FUND CAPITAL ASSET REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE FUND FOR PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL 9 10 ASSISTANCE TO SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT AND SUBMISSION OF 11 INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT GRANT 12 APPLICATIONS. 13 14 WHEREAS, The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), signed into law in November 2021, provides a federal investment of more than \$1 trillion that will be available 15 through a variety of competitive and formula grant programs through FY2026; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, The IIJA authorized 350 distinct programs across more than a dozen federal agencies and departments to distribute \$550 billion through competitive grants in support of 19 20 infrastructure planning and construction projects; and 21 22 WHEREAS, The Federal IIJA provides the City unprecedented opportunity to support 23 priority projects in the City's adopted 6-year Capital Improvement Plan, including roads, ports. 24 airport terminals, water and sewer utility projects, environmental remediation; community 25 resilience and cybersecurity; and 26 27 WHEREAS, To be successful projects must be nationally competitive based on alignment with program goals and the benefits provided, which requires significant project 28 29 planning time, engagement of partners and the public, environmental review, technical and 30 cost-benefit analyses, identification of matching funds and grant writing; and 31 32 WHEREAS, Given the complexity, time and cost associated with preparing Federal grant 33 applications, it is in the City's best interest to increase its capacity to research and strategically 34 prioritize grant programs to pursue and pre-positon projects for success; and 35 36 WHEREAS, Given the short timeframe between funding announcements and grant submission deadlines, the ability to leverage additional expertise as necessary to draft and 37 38 submit competitive applications will ensure the City of Homer is in the best possible position to benefit from the IIJA opportunity. 39 40
