7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
8 AMENDING THE FY23 CAPITAL BUDGET BY AUTHORIZING PASS
9 THROUGH FUNDS FOR THE STATE OF ALASKA PIONEER DOCK
10 FENDER REPAIR PROJECT.

12 WHEREAS, In November 2021, the fenders on the Pioneer Dock were damaged by a
13 State of Alaska vessel and the State's risk management office review concluded the State was
14 responsible for the damages; and

15
16 WHEREAS, The State developed an agreement with the Harbormaster to make repairs,
17 which called for the City to procure long lead time materials as well as
18 design/construction/inspection services and submit invoices to the State, which would pay
19 them directly; and

20
21 WHEREAS, The estimated cost of repair is under \$300,000; and

22
23 WHEREAS, The City has already purchased the materials and arranged with R&M, one
24 of the City's term contract consultants, to design the repairs as well as be the City's on-site
25 representative once construction is underway; and

26
27 WHEREAS, The City is now ready to put the construction out to bid and this work needs
28 to be done as soon as possible.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

32 Section 1. The FY23 Capital Budget is amended to authorize \$300,000 to be expended
33 from and reimbursement deposited in the account described below:

38 Section 2. The City Manager is a authorized to negotiate and execute a formal
39 agreement to memorialize the the State of Alaska's promise to pay for the costs of damage
40 and repair caused to the fenders of the City Pioneer Dock solely by a State of Alaska vessel.

42 Section3. This is a budget amendment ordinance only, is not permanent in nature, and
43 shall not be codified.




