**RESOLUTION 22-072**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA  
SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FIBER OPTIC SYSTEM  
WHICH WOULD CONNECT MANY OF THE TOWNS AND VILLAGES IN  
WESTERN ALASKA TO THE NATIONAL NETWORK OF HIGH-SPEED  
INTERNET.

WHEREAS, It is the policy of the State of Alaska and the United States to promote  
twenty-first century communications to every city, town, and village; and

WHEREAS, Homer, Alaska is connected by an undersea fiber optic cable to the  
contiguous 48 states; and


WHEREAS, Quintillion has proposed to construct a fiber optic system that would begin  
in Nome, Alaska and connect into the Homer junction; and

WHEREAS, Cities, towns and villages located between Nome and Homer would be  
afforded the opportunity to join the extended connectivity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby  
supports the construction of a fiber optic system which would connect many of the towns and  
villages in western Alaska to the national network of high speed internet.


