A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
ADOPTING JOINT RESOLUTION 2023-01 OF THE COUNCILS OF  
THE SELDOVIA VILLAGE TRIBE AND CITIES OF SELDOVIA AND  
HOMER ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP.

WHEREAS, The Cities of Seldovia and Homer have been working together to find ways  
to strengthen the relationships between the two cities; and

WHEREAS, As a federally recognized tribe and government that offers services in Homer  
and Seldovia, Seldovia Village Tribe has also been included in these discussions as the tribe's  
participation is vital to ensure our communities work together; and

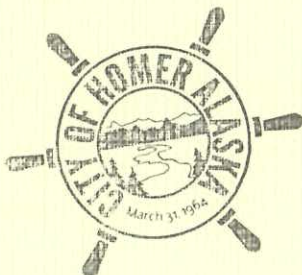
WHEREAS, There are a significant number of social, economic, and environmental  
linkages between Homer and Seldovia, providing and receiving valuable services from each  
other; and

WHEREAS, The City of Seldovia and Seldovia Village Tribe have shared with the City of  
Homer just how important Homer is to Seldovia in providing its residents with access to  
essential services and infrastructure that enhances the quality of life for the community; and

WHEREAS, The joint resolution 2023-01 is an opportunity to formally recognize the  
relationships, and encourage each governmental agency to continue to strengthen and  
expand those connections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby  
adopts Joint Resolution 2023-01 of the Councils of the Seldovia Village Tribe and Cities of  
Seldovia and Homer Establishing a Regional Partnership.


