CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 **ORDINANCE 22-76** 5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA 6 7 ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN FY 2022 STATE HOMELAND 8 SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,702.43 FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY & 9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (DHS&EM) TO UPGRADE THE CITY'S 10 RADIO COMMUNICATION SYSTEM, AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE 11 REQUEST TO CONTRACT WITH PROCOMM ALASKA AND 12 13 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE 14 THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 15 16 WHEREAS, The City's radio communication system supports the City of Homer's ability 17 to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from all hazard events; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Components of the system require upgrades to keep up with technological advances and maintain interoperability; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, The City is pleased to have been awarded \$43,702.43 from the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (DSH&EM) to procure and install two mobile 23 24 repeaters in Homer Police Department vehicles and upgrade three vehicle mounted mobile radios for the Homer Volunteer Fire Department; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, Motorola equipment is the only equipment that will interface properly with the City's existing communications system and allow system functionality to remain the same; 28 29 and 30 WHEREAS, The radio equipment must meet P25 Standards and ProComm Alaska is 31 32 Motorola's only certified APCO P25 Systems Specialist in the State of Alaska; and 33 WHEREAS, ProComm Alaska is the only firm in the state of Alaska authorized as a full 34 service manufacturer's representative for Motorola equipment, and has serviced City of Homer 35 communications equipment for thirty years, a sole source contract with ProComm is justified. 36 37 38 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 39 Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby accepts and appropriates an FY2022 State 40 Homeland Security Program Grant to the City of Homer from the DHS&EM in the amount of 41 \$43,702.43 for the purpose of upgrading the City's radio communication system as follows: 42
