1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/ 4 Port Director 5 **ORDINANCE 23-03** 6 7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 8 AMENDING THE FY23 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING 9 \$24,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD (USCG) HICKORY MAINTENANCE RESERVES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 10 CONTRACTING WITH ALASKA INDUSTRIAL SERVICES FOR FENDER 11 REPAIRS TO THE HICKORY BERTH AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY 12 MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE 13 14 DOCUMENTS. 15 16 WHEREAS, The Coast Guard leases berth space on the West side of the Pioneer dock to 17 moor their vessel the USCGC Hickory; and 18 19 WHEREAS, As part of their priority use agreement for the Hickory Berth space, a portion 20 of funds, paid monthly by the Coast Guard, is set aside in a separate City account (415-0397) 21 for use in the event of any required maintenance or repairs which has a current available balance of approximately \$170,000; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, Upon Port maintenance's last inspection the following repairs were noted 25 as needed for 3 of the hickory berth's 30,000 lbs. fenders: corroded welds- need to be scoured 26 and replaced, replace corroded fender resting tabs with new 1/2" flanges and gussets; and 27 28 WHEREAS, A scope of work and request for quote was sent to each of the 4 local 29 companies/individuals that have the equipment and expertise to complete such a repair; and 30 31 WHEREAS, Two entities were unresponsive, BP welding submitted a quote of \$11,310 per fender, and Alaska Industrial Services came in with a quote of \$8,000 per fender; and 32 33 34 WHEREAS, The City has had a positive working relationship with Alaska Industrial 35 Services on past projects and they came is as the lowest bid at \$24,000 total project cost; and 36 37 NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Homer Ordains: 38 39 Section 1: The FY23 Capital Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$24,000 from 40 the USCG Hickory Maintenance Reserves for the purpose of contracting with Alaska Industrial 41 Services for fender repairs to the Hickory berth and authorizing the City Manager to execute 42 the appropriate documents, as follows:
