CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/ 4 Port Director **ORDINANCE 23-04** 5 6 7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING THE FY23 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING 8 \$38,775 FROM THE PORT RESERVES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 9 PURCHASING TWO ADDITIONAL PARKING PAY KIOSKS AND 10 UPSAFETY PARKING MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE PACKAGE. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, Using the recommendations from the recent parking study provided by HDL Engineering Consultants, the port has been working on a multi phased spit parking project to 14 improve parking lots, expand paid parking areas, and support better parking management; 15 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, The City currently has ten T2 brand pay station kiosks that it uses for its 19 parking and camping needs and the Port wants to stay compatible with the existing 20 infrastructure in regards to additional infrastructure purchases; and 21 22 WHEREAS, Two additional pay kiosks are needed for the planned expanded paid 23 parking areas as well as a better customer interface support software that can help with 24 enforcement of the expanded paid parking footprint; and 25 WHEREAS, UPSafety has a comprehensive parking management and enforcement 26 software, training and equipment package that is well recommended and that is also 27 28 compatible with the City's current T2 infrastructure; and 29 WHEREAS, The total cost for these two kiosks is \$22,870.75 and the UPSafety package 30 costs \$15,904 for a total cost of \$38,775; and 31 32 WHEREAS, Revenues generated from these day use fee parking areas that adjoin the 33 State Right-of-Way (ROW) may only be used for parking improvements and reimbursement for 34 such improvements per AKDOT policy; and 35 36 WHEREAS, Revenues from parking areas adjoining State ROW shall be transferred to the 37 Port Reserves at the end of each year budget close out to reimburse the enterprise fund for all 38 infrastructure improvement expenditures tied to this parking improvement project. 39 40 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 41
