6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
7 DECLARING CERTAIN CITY OWNED EQUIPMENT SURPLUS,
8 OBSOLETE AND UNNEEDED AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
9 MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF THE USED AND SURPLUS EQUIPMENT
10 IN ACCORDANCE WITH HOMER CITY CODE 18.30.010-020 AND
11 18.30.040(B).

13 WHEREAS, The City is currently soliciting bids for surplus, obsolete, and unneeded
14 materials and equipment; and

15
16 WHEREAS, Homer City Code 18.30.020 states that no supplies, materials, equipment or
17 other personal property of a value of more than \$5,000 may be sold or otherwise disposed of
18 until the City Council has declared, by motion or resolution, such property surplus, obsolete,
19 or unneeded, or that the transaction is otherwise in the best interest of the City; and

21 WHEREAS, The following items have an estimated value of more than \$5,000–

- 22
- 23 • Ford Crew Cab Long Bed Truck Estimated value \$10,000
 - 24 • Caterpillar Grader Estimated value \$6,000
 - 25 • Caterpillar Loader Estimated value \$10,000
- 26

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby declares the
28 Ford Crew Cab long bed truck, Caterpillar grader, and Caterpillar loader to be surplus,
29 obsolete, and unneeded, and authorizes the City Manager to dispose of it pursuant to either
30 HCC 18.30.010-020 or HCC 18.30.040(b) in the best interests of the City.


