10	WHEREAS, It is in the interests of the City to make allowances for uses in districts
11	according to the guidance set forth in the 2018 Homer Comprehensive Plan and the purpose
12	of the district described in Homer City Code; and
13	WHIEDEAC The Harry Division Constitution of the constitution of th
14 15	WHEREAS, The Homer Planning Commission, using the guidance of the 2018 Homer
16	Comprehensive Plan and the Purpose statement in code for the zoning district, has identified
17	conditional uses and structures that would be more appropriately listed as permitted uses; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, The Town Center District has adopted extensive regulations including
20	architectural standards and site development standards which provides adequate measures
21	applicable to all developments; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, The proposed ordinance clears up unintended conflict of uses.
24	
25	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:
26	
27	Section 1. Homer City Code Chapter 21.20, Town Center District is amended to read as
28	follows:
29 30	21.20.030 Conditional uses and structures.
31	21.20.050 Conditional uses and structures.
32	The following uses may be permitted in the Town Center District when authorized by
33	conditional use permit issued in accordance with Chapter 21.71 HCC:
34	
35	a. Planned unit developments, limited only to uses otherwise permitted in this district;
36	
37	b. Indoor recreational facilities;

39	€b. Light or custom manufacturing, repair, fabricating, and assembly, provided such
40	use, including storage of materials, is wholly within an enclosed building;

42	d <u>c</u> . Other uses approved pursuant to HCC 21.04.020;
43 44	o Outdoor regreational facilities:
7*1	e. Outdoor recreational facilities;

46	fd. Customary accessory uses to any of the permitted uses listed in the TCD district;
47	provided, that a separate permit shall not be issued for the construction of any type of
48	accessory building prior to that of the main building;

50	ge. One wind energy system having a rated capacity exceeding 10 kilowatts; provided,
51	that it is the only wind energy system on any capacity of the lot.
52	
53	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the Homer City Council.
54	
55	Section 4. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included
56	in the City code.
