### **Summary Statement:**

The Library Advisory Board held their annual review of the library fees at their February 21, 2023 regular meeting. At that meeting, the board approved a motion to increase the fees for interlibrary loan to reflect increased postage costs.

The changes are as follows:

- The \$3.00 fee for interlibrary loans for books increased to \$5.00
- The \$4.00 fee for interlibrary loans for all other types of materials increased to \$6.00
