CITY OF HOMER 1 HOMER, ALASKA 2 3 City Manager Public Works Director 4 5 **RESOLUTION 23-078** 6 7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 8 APPROVING A CONTRACT TO MACSWAIN APPRAISALS LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$55,200 TO PROVIDE APPRAISAL SERVICES TO 9 SUPPORT THE KACHEMAK SPONGE PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING 10 THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE 11 12 APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 13 WHEREAS, The City Council included funds in the FY 24 Capital Budget to support the 14 Kachemak Sponge Green Infrastructure Storm Water Management Project; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, The City has been offered a grant from NOAA, through the Kachemak Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (KBNERR) which could be used to acquire wetlands to be 18 preserved in conservation and use as part of the Kachemak Sponge wetland treatment system; 19 20 and 21 WHEREAS, In order to acquire the wetlands with federal funds, we need appraisals that 22 comply with the Uniform Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisition (UASFLA), which are 23 more stringent than the more typically used Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal 24 25 Practice (USPAP); and 26 WHEREAS, MacSwain Associates, LLC, ("MacSwain") Anchorage, has the necessary 27 credentials and produced the appraisals that supported the NOAA grant application; and 28 29 WHEREAS, MacSwain submitted a proposal to provide a new set of appraisals, for the 30 total contract value not to exceed \$55,200 (\$52,200 for professional services plus \$3,000 for 31 32 expenses); and 33 34 WHEREAS, This award contingent on the adoption of Ordinance 23-46 and is not final until written notification is received by the firm from the City of Homer. 35 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, awards a 37 contract for professional real estate appraisal services to MacSwain Associates LLC authorizes 38 the City Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents. 39
