AND STATING INTENT TO FUND 25% OF THE UPDATED GENERAL 11 12 INVESTIGATION COST. 13 WHEREAS, Homer Harbor Expansion has been the City's highest ranked priority capital 14 improvement project since 2004 to (1) meet moorage demand, (2) address overcrowding and 15 associated navigational safety concerns and high maintenance costs, and (3) support regional, 16 17 statewide and national marine transportation, the maritime economy and national security: 18 and 19 WHEREAS, The Homer Harbor Expansion's General Investigation (GI) with the US Army 20 Corps of Engineers (USACE) was successfully initiated in 2023; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, The cost of the General Investigation Study was set per the USACE Project Management Plan (PMP) at \$3,000,000, as a shared partnership between the USACE, the State 24 of Alaska, and the City (\$1.5 million federal/ \$750,000 State of AK/ \$750,000 City of Homer); and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, After reaching the Alternatives and Measures Milestone, the USACE project development team updated the PMP to include geotechnical and ship simulation data that 28 would have historically been in the pre-construction engineering and design phase of project 29 design, but USACE has found these to lead to significant cost overruns in the recent past and 30 has determined that these cost overruns are avoidable and additional work is now required to 31 32 complete the study with sufficient data to develop the most realistic benefit to cost ratio (BCA); 33 and 34 35 WHEREAS, Based on a cost estimate provided by USACE, this additional work for the GI 36 study phase comes with an additional cost of \$1,154,093 to be similarly shared between the 37 Federal and Local partners; and WHEREAS, The City is at a decision point to either concur with the PMP changes, or reject them, 38 which would end the General Investigation and any further work on this project; and 39

WHEREAS, The City Council, with support from the Homer Port & Harbor Advisory

Commission, wishes to continue to pursue the completion of the General Investigation which

will require concurrence with the PMP and an additional \$577,046.50 in local sponsor match:

WHEREAS, This project has demonstrated statewide importance and the Council is seeking a continued 50/50 local cost share with the State of Alaska to fund the total additional local match in the amount of \$577,046.50; and

WHEREAS, Following this Resolution, the City Council will next consider a funding ordinance to appropriate half of the total additional local match in the amount of \$288,524 from the Port and Harbor Reserves Harbor Match Account to officially set aside the City's share of the local sponsor match; and

WHEREAS, Signing the updated Project Management Plan does not immediately obligate the City to pay the local match; and

WHEREAS, It is acknowledged that the City is in a unique circumstance with a gap in Federal funding for federal fiscal year 2024 which will create a slowdown and delay the General Investigation, and that the continuation of the GI and expenditure of funds on the GI is dependent upon continued Federal funding; and

WHEREAS, The City Council believes it is prudent to continue to explore the options for a harbor expansion to meet the needs of our overcrowded fleet and to improve safety among other reasons previous stated; and

 WHEREAS, The City Council is greatly appreciative of our Federal and State partners and recognizes the success and continuation of this project lies in continued active partnership and investment between all three, and that the City will be prudent and continue to assess its relative risk and investment for the completion of the General Investigation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby:

 1. Authorizes the City Manager to sign the revised Project Management Plan by negotiating and executing the required documents with USACE.

 Directs the Council sponsors for this project to prepare an Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$288,523.25 from Port and Harbor Reserves Matching Fund Account to fund 50% of the required local sponsor match.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska recognizes the critical importance of continued regional and statewide partnerships for the Homer Harbor Expansion and:

 1. Directs the Council sponsors for this project to prepare a Resolution supporting and requesting additional match funding from the State of Alaska in the amount of \$288,523.

Authorizes the Council sponsors to contact the Kenai Peninsula Borough requesting a similar Resolution of support for additional State match funding from the Borough Assembly.
