7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
8 APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF A LIGHTHOUSE  
9 SCULPTURE CREATED BY MOOSERUN METALSMITHS OF HOMER,  
10 ALASKA, COMMISSIONED BY THE STUART CRAIG FAMILY TO BE  
11 LOCATED IN THE GARDENS AT THE BAYCREST HILL OVERLOOK  
12 AND INCLUDED IN THE CITY OF HOMER MUNICIPAL ART  
13 COLLECTION.

15 WHEREAS, Many residents and visitors find the view of the Kachemak Bay when topping  
16 the rise at Baycrest entrancing, whether it is their first time or 100<sup>th</sup> time, and having the feeling  
17 of being “home” when they see the spectacular view of natural wonder and beauty; and

19 WHEREAS, The proposed sculpture of a lighthouse made of powder coated steel, rising  
20 to the height of five feet fixed with a solar powered light, will provide tribute of a centuries old  
21 system of showing the way home and safe navigation; and

23 WHEREAS, The Parks, Art, Recreation, and Culture Commission (PARCAC) have  
24 reviewed the donation to the City of Homer and recommended that City Council approve and  
25 accept the sculpture for inclusion in the Municipal Art Collection.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, hereby  
28 approves and accepts the donation of a Lighthouse Sculpture created by Mooserun  
29 Metalsmiths of Homer, Alaska, commissioned by the Stuart Craig Family to be Located in the  
30 Gardens at the Baycrest Hill Overlook and Included in the City of Homer Municipal Art  
31 Collection.



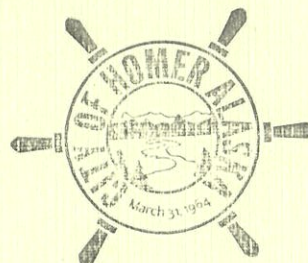
