

## RESOLUTION 24-013

WHEREAS, Construction, shipping, and mobilization costs to remote portions of Alaska have outpaced the national consumer price index since the pandemic; and



WHEREAS, The United States Bureau of Labor Statistics CPI calculator indicates that \$5M in July of 2006, when the Senate Bill 291 was enacted, would be inflated to \$7,511,000 as of July 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, urges the Governor and the Alaska Legislature to amend AS 29.60.800 raising the maximum Harbor facility Grant Fund award to \$7,500,000 per eligible project.


