6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
7 AMENDING THE FY24 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING
8 \$7,350 FROM THE PORT RESERVES FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF
9 ISSUING A TASK ORDER TO ALASKA HARBORS CONSULTING, LLC
10 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,350 FOR DESIGN AND COST
11 ESTIMATING SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY'S FY2024 PORT
12 INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM GRANT
13 APPLICATION TO REPLACE FLOAT SYSTEMS 4 AND 1 IN THE SMALL
14 BOAT HARBOR.

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16 WHEREAS, City Council identified Small Boat Harbor float replacement as a high priority
17 project in their 2022 Visioning session and designated it a Legislative Priority project in the
18 City's FY25 Capital Improvement Plan; and

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20 WHEREAS, In 2023, the City submitted an FY2023 Port Infrastructure Development
21 Program (PIDP) grant application for Federal assistance to replace Float Systems 4 and 1 in
22 Homer's Small Boat Harbor; and

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24 WHEREAS, After Federal review, the City's project, Homer Port FREIGHT was submitted
25 to the US Department of Transportation Secretary's for final funding consideration, but was
26 ultimately not selected for award; and

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28 WHEREAS, In a debrief of the Homer Port FREIGHT submission with PIDP program
29 officials, the City of Homer was highly encouraged to resubmit a proposal in the FY2024 PIDP
30 grant cycle with 30% design completion and an engineers' cost estimate, including Build
31 America, Buy America specifications; and

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33 WHEREAS, The US Department of Transportation Maritime Administration has
34 published a preliminary Notice of Funding Opportunity for the FY2024 PIDP and the City
35 intends to reapply; and

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37 WHEREAS, Alaska Harbors Consulting, LLC, a term contractor for the City of Homer,
38 completed a comprehensive harbor condition assessment, which informed the City's FY2023
39 PIDP grant application and attended an application review with the US Department of
40 Transportation Maritime Administration; and

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42 WHEREAS, Administration requested a proposal from Alaska Harbors Consulting, LLC
43 to provide a 30% design and an engineer's cost estimate for replacing Harbor Float Systems 4
44 and 1.

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

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48 Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends the FY24 Capital Budget by
49 appropriating \$7,350 as follows:

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

58 Section 2. The Homer City Council hereby authorizes a Task Order to Alaska Harbors
59 Consulting, LLC for design and cost estimating services for replacing Float Systems 4 and 1 in
60 support of an FY24 PIDP grant in an amount not to exceed \$7,350 and authorizes the City
61 Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.


62 Section 3. This is a budget amendment ordinance, is not permanent in nature, and shall
