Define "specie" as gold or silver valued primarily on its metal content and in the 18 form of coin or bullion stamped or imprinted with its weight and purity and 2. Not allow municipalities to tax specie; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Alaska's constitution, Article 10 - Local Government, begins by stating "The 21 purpose of the article is to provide for maximum local self-government ... A liberal 22 construction shall be given to the powers of local government units."; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Municipalities within Alaska currently receive tax revenues from the trade in 25 gold and silver; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Removing a source of tax revenue from municipalities is not fair to 28 29 municipalities, particularly at a time when state revenue sharing with municipalities is uncertain and the State is forcing municipalities to take on more and more funding burdens. 30 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, opposes 32 33 **HB3**. 34 35 PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, THIS 12th day of February 2024. 36 37 38 CITY OF HOMER 39 40 41 KEN CASTNER, MAYOR 42
