f. He shall execute and enforce ordinances and resolutions of the City, administer all contracts entered into by the City and see that provisions of all franchises, permits, leases, and privileges granted by the City are observed. Supervise the enforcement of municipal law and carry out the directives of the Council, administer all contracts entered into by the City and see that provisions of all franchises, permits, leases, and privileges granted by the City are observed.

g. He shall appoint and remove the heads of all departments, boards, bureaus and all other officers and employees of the City, except the City Attorney, who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Council, and he shall have supervision and control over them and their work with power to transfer an employee from one department to the other. He shall supervise all other City departments to the end of obtaining the utmost efficiency in each of them. Hire and, as needed, remove the heads of all departments and employees of the City, exercising supervision and control over them and their work with the aim of maximizing efficiency, and shall have the power to transfer an employee from one department to another.

h. He shall supervise the operation of all public utilities owned and operated by the City and shall have general supervision of all City owned property.

i. He shall act as purchasing agent for all City departments, subject to provisions of the annual budget. All purchases shall be made by requisition approved by him. Exercise custody over all real and personal property of the municipality and supervise the operation of all public utilities owned and operated by the City.

j. He shall take part in and may enter into all discussions by the City Council but shall have no vote. Act as purchasing agent for all City departments, subject to provisions of the annual budget and the City's procurement policy.

k. Take part in and may enter into all discussions by the City Council but shall have no vote.

l. Perform other duties required by law or by the Council.
