12	WHEREAS, Sales taxes provide a significant source of revenue to the City of Homer for
13	funding public services and infrastructure; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, The equitable collection of sales taxes ensures financial fairness for all
16	entities conducting business within the City of Homer and Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB); and
17	
18	WHEREAS, The growth of online marketplaces and short-term rental platforms has
19 20	created new challenges and opportunities for tax collection; and
21	WHEREAS, New short-term rentals come to the market on a regular basis, and
22	anecdotal evidence suggests that many new and existing short-term rental owners are not
23	aware of the requirement that they collect sales tax from their guests; and
24	aware of the requirement that they contect suites tax norm then guests, and
25	WHEREAS, Airbnb is a significant platform for short-term rentals, with a substantial
26	presence in Homer and throughout the KPB; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Identifying and reaching out to owners of new and existing short-term
29	rentals appearing on Airbnb has proven challenging for City of Homer staff; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, Airbnb has offered to collect sales taxes directly from guests at the time they
32	pay for their vacation rental and associated services; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, Direct collection of sales taxes by Airbnb would streamline the tax collection
35	process, reducing administrative burdens on local hosts and ensuring a fair playing field for all
36	visitor-hosting businesses in the City of Homer and the KPB; and
37 38	WHEREAS, The KPB Sales Tax Division of the Finance Department collects city sales
39	taxes for purchases made within the City of Homer, and the Alaska Remote Sellers Sales Tax
40	Commission (ARSSTC) collects city sales taxes for remote (online) sales to customers with City
41	of Homer addresses; and
