29	otherwise disposal of personal property or an interest therein, to any other municipality when
30	City Council determines it is in the best interests of the City.

32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby
33	declares the above noted equipment to be un-needed and surplus and authorizes the City
34	Manager to dispose of it pursuant to Homer City Code 18.30.010, 18.30.020 or 18.30.040 (b) in
35	the best interests of the City.
