CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/ Public Works Director 4 5 **RESOLUTION 24-061** 6 7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOAN 8 9 AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF 10 ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR AN ALASKA CLEAN WATER 11 STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN AGREEMENT IN THE NOT TO EXCEED PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$246,600 FOR THE BUNNELL 12 13 AVENUE/CHARLES WAY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. 14 15 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council approved the creation of the Bunnell 16 Avenue/Charles Way Sewer Improvement Special Assessment District with the adoption of 17 Resolution 21-017(A); and 18 19 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council authorized the City Manager to apply to the State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) for an Alaska Clean Water State 20 Revolving Fund Loan in the amount of \$514,153, with the adoption of Resolution 22-018 (Loan); 21 22 and 23 WHEREAS, ADEC approved the City's loan application conditioned upon the execution 24 and delivery of a loan agreement setting forth terms and conditions of the Loan (Loan 25 26 Agreement) which shall be in substantially the form presented to, and made part of the records 27 of this meeting; and 28 29 WHEREAS, The Loan, referred to by ADEC as ACWF No. 409361, is for an amount not to exceed the principal amount of \$246,600, with a 1.7938% finance charge (consisting of an 30 interest rate of 1.2938% and fee of 0.5%), and a term of 20 years; and 31 32 33 WHEREAS, The Loan will be repaid with amounts deposited in the Homer Accelerated 34 Water and Sewer Program (HAWSP) Fund (25% of the Loan) and amounts collected from the Bunnell/Charles Way Sewer Special Assessment District (75% of the Loan); the Loan is not a 35 general obligation of the City; and 36 37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska authorizes 38 the City Manager to execute and deliver the Loan Agreement in the form now presented at this 39 40 meeting, but with such changes, modifications, additions and deletions therein as shall to him be necessary, desirable, or appropriate, the execution thereof to constitute conclusive 41

evidence of the City's approval of the terms and conditions therein stated.
