1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/ Public Works Director 4 5 **RESOLUTION 24-062** 6 7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA 8 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOAN 9 AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR AN ALASKA DRINKING 10 WATER FUND LOAN IN THE NOT TO EXCEED PRINCIPLE AMOUNT 11 12 OF \$415,670 FOR THE BUNNELL AVE/CHARLES WAY WATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. 13 14 15 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council approved the creation of the Bunnell/Charles Way 16 Water and Sewer Special Assessment District with the adoption of Resolution 21-017(A); and 17 18 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council authorized the City Manager to apply to the State of 19 Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) for an Alaska Drinking Water Fund Loan in the amount of \$473,787, with the adoption of Resolution 22-018 (Loan); and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, ADEC approved the City's loan application conditioned upon the execution and delivery of a loan agreement setting forth terms and conditions of the Loan (Loan 23 24 Agreement) which shall be in substantially the form presented to and made part of the records 25 of this meeting; and 26 27 WHEREAS, The Loan, referred to by ADEC as ADWF No. 409351-S, is for an amount not 28 to exceed the principal amount of \$415,670, with a 1.7938% finance charge (consisting of an interest rate of 1.2938% and fee of 0.5%), and a term of 20 years; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, The Loan will be repaid with amounts deposited in the Homer Accelerated Water and Sewer Program (HAWSP) Fund (25% of the Loan) and amounts collected from the 32 33 Bunnell/Charles Way Water Special Assessment District (75% of the Loan); the Loan is not a general obligation of the City; and 34 35 36 WHEREAS, The Loan Agreement provides for a \$225,690 subsidy in the form of principal forgiveness of the Loan amount. 37 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska authorizes the City Manager to execute and deliver the Loan Agreement in the form now presented at this 40 meeting, but with such changes, modifications, additions and deletions therein as shall to him 41

be necessary, desirable, or appropriate, the execution thereof to constitute conclusive evidence of the City's approval of the terms and conditions therein stated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer, Alaska that the City Manager, or any other person designated by the City Manager, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver for an on behalf of the City any and all additional documents or other papers and perform all such acts as he may deem necessary or appropriate in order to implement and carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Resolution does hereby incorporate by reference as though fully set out herein the Loan Agreement herein above referenced as presented to this meeting. Further, the recitals to this Resolution are hereby made a part of this Resolution, including all defined terms not herein defined.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
