Evans 27 Addition Lot 1, also known as Kenai Peninsula Borough Tax Parcel Parcels 28 29 17316066 and 17316067; and 30 31 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC entered into their first Recreational Use Agreement (RUA) regarding these trails in the winter of 2008 and has stayed current through 2024 with use 32 33 agreements; and 34 35 WHEREAS, The City and KNSC wish to enter into a revised RUA to include the City owned 36 land on Roger's Loop and also for the construction of a equipment shed on the property; and 37 38 WHEREAS, The Parks, Art, Recreation and Culture Advisory Commission recommended approval at their May 16, 2024 regular meeting; and 39 40 41 WHEREAS, An RUA between the City and KNSC is in the best interest of the public 42 because it promotes public-private partnerships, saves tax dollars, enhances recreational and economic development opportunities, and provides access to public lands for the use and 43
