Homer Harbor Expansion 33 2. Multi-Use Community Center 34 3. Homer Harbor Critical Float System Replacements: Systems 4 & 1 35 4. Slope Stability & Erosion Mitigation Program 36 5. City Hall ADA Accessibility Project 37 6. Karen Hornaday Park Improvements 38 7. Homer Spit Erosion Mitigation 39 8. A-Frame Water Transmission Line 40 9. New Public Works Facility 41 42 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise 43 appropriate State and Federal representatives and personnel of the City's FY 2026 capital

project priorities and take appropriate steps to provide necessary background information.
