AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
AMENDING THE FY25 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING
\$40,000 FROM THE HOMER ACCELERATED ROADS AND TRAILS
(HART) ROADS FUND TO PURCHASE SPEED MONITORING
DEVICES.

WHEREAS, Concerns of speeding have been expressed by citizens in several areas our
community; and

WHEREAS, The Homer Police Department regularly patrols the roads throughout the
City and responds to calls based level of the emergency, so aren't always available to write
tickets when speeding occurs; and

WHEREAS, Speed monitoring devices are tools the City uses to help fill the gap as they
can alert drivers when they are exceeding the speed limit on our local roads; and

WHEREAS, Speed monitoring devices also collect traffic speed and volume data and
some will take images of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, The City's existing mobile speed monitoring device still functions but is older
and doesn't collect data like the newer models; and

WHEREAS, Purchasing a new mobile speed monitoring device and two additional post
mounted devices will benefit the City by alerting drivers when they are speeding and collecting
data to help identify areas that need more enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends the FY25 Capital Budget by
appropriating \$40,000 as follows:


