CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/Port Director 4 **ORDINANCE 24-64** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, EXTENDING THE EXEMPTION OF WORK AND SEINE SKIFFS 7 8 ATTACHED TO MOTHERSHIPS FROM MOORAGE FEES THROUGH 9 2025. 10 WHEREAS, Before January 2023 work and seine skiffs that were attached to their 11 mothership in the Homer Harbor were exempt from moorage fees; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Ordinance 24-09 amended Tariff No. 1 and removed the work/seine skiff 14 exemption tariff; and 15 from the 16 17 WHEREAS, Numerous commercial fishermen testified to the Port and Harbor Advisory 18 Commission (PHAC) during the April meeting to express that this policy change comes at a time 19 when the fishing fleet is facing historic challenges within the industry; and 20 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council adopted Resolution 24-057 to amend the tariff and 21 reinstate the moorage skiff exemption with an expiration date of December 31, 2024; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, Resolution 24-108, City Council requested that the Governor of the State of Alaska designate the area of Prince William Sound as an area impacted by an economic 25 26 disaster; and 27 WHEREAS, On September 25, 2024, the PHAC passed a motion recommending the 28 removal of the work skiff exemption, while acknowledging the difficult timing and 29 unanimously recommended that the City Council postpone this change to the work skiff rule 30 until December 31, 2025, due to the historically low pink salmon return. 31 32 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, amends the Homer Tariff No. 1 as follows: 34 35 36 Section 1. Homer Tariff No. 1 is hereby amended to add Section 28.03 that reads as 37 follows: 38 28.03. APPLICATION OF RATES/WORK SKIFFS - Until December 31, 2025, properly registered 39 seine skiffs or work skiffs attached to the mother vessel are not subject to these moorage rates. 40 Work skiff is defined as a boat that is usually carried on the deck or super structure of the 41 mother vessel and is regularly used in the commercial enterprise of the mother vessel. not exceed the allowed criteria for the size of stall. If it does exceed, the skiff must be moved to a transient area and moorage fees will apply. Section 2.
