14	(ADF&G) that the City of Homer is eligible to receive a portion of the 2018 East Side Set Gillnet
15	and 2020 Upper Cook Inlet salmon declared disaster relief funding; and

17	WHEREAS, The distribution is part of the spending plan authored by the ADF&G to
18	provide relief in the form of direct payments to municipalities and boroughs that rely on
19	revenue from Upper Cook Inlet salmon landings and related port and harbor economic activity
20	to support local services; and

22	WHEREAS, The City's allotment, a one-time payment in the amount of \$20,799.96 is a
23	pro-rated percentage of the disaster funding based on each affected community's share of
24	total losses among all eligible communities.
