17	camera poles between ramps one through five at \$254,000; and
18	carriera potes between ramps one through live at 3254,000, and
19	WHEREAS, Port staff was able to reduce overall costs by coordinating contractors and
20	working with City staff to install the camera poles through separate tasks; and
21	working with only stain to motals and same a potes among woop and to the carry
22	WHEREAS, Poles have been installed and the next step in the project is to supply
23	electricity to this infrastructure; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, We received three bids and would like to proceed with the lowest qualified
26	quote of \$22,101.

28	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:
