**RESOLUTION 25-015**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA  
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO STRUCTURED COMMUNICATIONS  
SYSTEMS, INC OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA IN THE AMOUNT OF  
\$24,000 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CITY OF HOMER  
CYBERSECURITY PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO  
NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, In 2024, the City of Homer conducted a cybersecurity risk assessment using  
the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework, which  
found, among other things, that the City should develop a cybersecurity plan to appropriately  
manage risks to its digital infrastructure and data; and

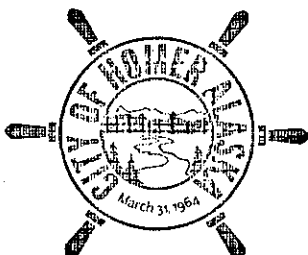
WHEREAS, The Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency  
Management has awarded the City of Homer a grant to develop a cybersecurity plan through  
the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP); and

WHEREAS, The Alaska Municipal League (AML) has arranged procurement with  
Structured Communications Systems, Inc. through a competitive bidding process to provide  
cybersecurity consulting services to its members; and


WHEREAS, In 2024, Structured Communications Systems, Inc. conducted the  
cybersecurity risk assessment for the City of Homer, giving them a specialized level of expertise  
and familiarity with the sensitive details of the City's cybersecurity risk management profile.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby  
awards a contract to Structured Communications Systems, Inc of Anchorage, Alaska in the  
amount of \$24,000 for the development of a City of Homer cybersecurity plan and authorizing  
the City Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.


