1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/Port Director 4 **RESOLUTION 25-019** 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA 6 AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR FISH GRINDING FACILITY 7 OPERATIONS TO THE ALASKAN FISH FACTORY, AND 8 9 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE 10 THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 11 12 WHEREAS, The fish grinding facility operates from May 1 to October 31 and has been operated by an outside company through a contract negotiated through the Request for 13 Proposal (RFP) process on a periodic basis; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, In 2014, 2018, and 2021 the sole respondent to the City's RFP for operations 17 of the grinding facility was The Alaskan Fish Factory; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Under HCC 3.16.060, single source procurement is defined as "procurement of supplies, materials, services, or construction when the contractor or consultant has a 20 preexisting relationship with the City and provides a specialized level of expertise, proprietary 21 22 technology, or a service that is difficult to replicate by other vendors."; and 23 24 WHEREAS, The company operating the fish grinding facility is responsible to provide 25 labor to grind fish waste, routine maintenance to the fish grinder and other equipment, provide 20 non-insulated fish totes with lids, provide a forklift, verify deliveries, and collect samples 26 27 required by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation permit for fish grinding 28 operations; and 29 30 WHEREAS, The Port & Harbor and The Alaskan Fish Factory have proven to have a 31 positive working relationship, and this service would be difficult to replicate by other vendors, 32 supports utilizing a single source procurement; and 33 34 WHEREAS, City Staff and The Alaskan Fish Factory have expressed mutual interest in a 35 5-year term for the next contract for services to operate the Fish Grinding Facility; and 36 WHEREAS, The funds for this service are already appropriated in the Port Operating 37 Budget. 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby 40 awards the contract for Fish Grinding Facility Operations to The Alaskan Fish Factory as a sole 41

source procurement.
