I. Issue: The purpose of this Memorandum is to request \$71,000 for the engineering work associated with the Highland Drive Culvert Replacement Project.

II. Background:

Public Works staff was made aware of the side slope of Highland Drive sluffing in Mid-January due to the wet winter. This location is where Highland Drive crosses the headwaters of Bidarki Creek. Bidarki Creek flows through a culvert located at the base of the canyon crossing with side slopes approaching a 1:1 slope. The upstream side of the road crossing is approximately 15-feet to the stream bed elevation and the downstream side of the road crossing is approximately 30-feet to the stream elevation. The age of the culvert is estimated to be approximately 30-years old and is well past its expected life.

The Public Works Department is closely monitoring the conditions on Highland Drive because the erosion, or sloughing, is continuing to occur and is working its way towards the road. This action has already exposed approximately 5-feet of road bed fabric. As of February 17, 2025, the erosion is within approximately 5-feet of the guardrail along the road edge. As this erosion progresses, the Public Works Department anticipates the road will have to be closed for safety pending the repair. All residents will have access to their properties during the anticipated road closure, however some residents may be temporarily inconvenienced by having to access the Sterling Highway by traveling west to Roger's Loop instead of east to West Hill Road.

The complexity of the repair work requires detailed design plans due to the nature of the site, depth of the crossing of Bidarki Creek, and the continuous flow of Bidarki Creek. The Public Works Department reached out to three qualified Term Contractors for a bid and selected the lowest responsive bidder. The design work is anticipated to take approximately 60 to 90-days

to complete. Every effort will be made to expedite this process so repair work occurs as close to spring break-up as possible.

Once the design is completed, an ordinance will be brought forward requesting funding to replace the culvert and restore the road. The repair work is beyond the capacity of the Public Works Department's staffing level and equipment available, and must be hired out.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS:

City Council appropriates \$71,000 towards the engineering design of the Highland Drive Culvert Replacement Project.
