ORDINANCE 25-31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING THE FY25 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING AN
ADDITIONAL \$72,382 FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNASSIGNED
FUND BALANCE FOR A CHANGE ORDER TO THE FUEL ISLAND
REPLACEMENT CONTRACT TO ALSO INCLUDE UNDERGROUND
TANK REMOVAL.

WHEREAS, The Cities two existing underground fuel storage tanks failed their routine
certification inspection and are required to be removed and replaced; and

WHEREAS, New aboveground storage tanks were budgeted in the FY25 Capital Budget;
and

WHEREAS, The City bid and awarded the project to Prism Design and Construction of
Anchorage to provide and install the new aboveground storage tanks; and

WHEREAS, The current project was bid without the underground tank removal to
ensure a seamless transition between underground storage tanks to aboveground storage
tanks without an interruption of fuel supply to the Cities fleet; and

WHEREAS, Prism is certified to do the underground tank removal and has provided a
quote for this work which includes temporary tanks to ensure a seamless transition where the
Cities fleet will not have a gap in fuel supply; and

WHEREAS, This supplemental appropriation will allow the Public Works Department
the ability to preserve the remaining funding balance from the initial appropriation to cover
unexpected expenses related to the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends the FY25 Capital Budget by
appropriating an additional \$72,382 as follows:

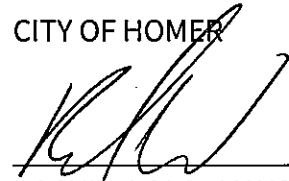
