(a) If grant funds that are received during the fiscal year exceed the amounts of such 41 funds appropriated by this ordinance by not more than \$25,000, the affected 42 appropriation is increased by the amount of the increase in receipts. 43 44 (b) If grant funds that are received during the fiscal year exceed the amounts 45 appropriated by this ordinance by not more than \$25,000, the appropriation from 46 city funds for the affected program may be reduced by the excess if the reduction is 47 consistent with applicable federal and state statutes. 48 49 (c) If grant funds that are received during the fiscal year fall short of the amounts 50 appropriated by this ordinance, the affected appropriation is reduced by the 51 amount of the shortfall in receipts. 52 53 Section 5. Donations or charitable contributions. If donations or contributions are 54 received during the fiscal year that exceed the amounts of such funds appropriated by this 55 56 ordinance by not more than \$5,000, the affected appropriation is increased by the amount of the increase in receipts. 57 58 <u>Section 6</u>. A copy of the adopted budget shall be certified by the City Clerk and filed in 59 the office of the City Clerk. 60 61 <u>Section 7</u>. The supporting Line Item Budget detail as presented by the Administration 62 and reviewed by the City Council is incorporated as part of this Budget Ordinance. 63 64 <u>Section 8</u>. The property tax mill levy is set at 4.5 mills for 2025. 65 66 67 <u>Section 9</u>.
