1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 RESOLUTION 12-103(A) 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, 7 ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER 8 INTO A NEW SHORT TERM LEASE WITH THE HOMER 9 BOYS AND CLUB AND TO EXTEND THE CLUB'S OCCUPANCY OF THE LOWER LEVEL OF THE HOMER 10 EDUCATION AND RECREATION COMPLEX (HERC) 11 BUILDING FOR ONE ADDITIONAL YEAR BEGINNING ON 12 13 JANUARY 1, 2013 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2013. 14 WHEREAS, The City of Homer entered into a Lease and Security Agreement with the 15 Homer Boys and Girls Club dated January 1, 2012; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The City Council approved a Lease Extension and Amendment in May of 18 2012 through adoption of Resolution 12-046(A); and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, The current lease expires on December 31, 2012; and 22 WHEREAS, The Homer Boys and Girls Club provides a valuable service to the 23 community, the current facility is ideal for its programs, and no other suitable facility or location 24 25 has been identified; and 26 WHEREAS, The City Council has added renovation of this building to its Capital 27 Improvement Program Priority List, authorized a Community Development Block Grant 28 application to upgrade the area occupied by the Club, and appropriated funds to conduct an 29 engineering analysis of code upgrades that would be required for new or different occupancies in 30 the building; and 31 32 WHEREAS, Since the building must be heated minimally in any event, it makes sense to 33 extend the Boys and Girls Club occupancy for another year until a long term use and plan for the 34 facility can be developed. 35 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council finds that it is in 37 the best interest of the City to enter into another short term, one year lease with the Homer Boys 38 and Girls Club and to allow that program to continue while a longer term solution for the 39

building is developed.
