18	Building Resilient Infrastructure & Communities (BRIC) grant program to support states, local
19	communities, tribes and territories as they undertake hazard mitigation projects, reducing the

22	WHEREAS, The City Council passed Resolution 22-086 authorizing the City to apply for
23	a FEMA BRIC grant to adopt and implement the 2021 Edition of the International Building Code;

25	WHIEDEAC The Charlest of a large and the Control of
26	WHEREAS, The city staff submitted an application for a FEMA BRIC grant of up to
27 28	\$500,000 to adopt and implement International Building Code in December of 2022; and
29	WHEREAS, The City was notified on April 4, 2025, by the Department of Homeland
30	Security (DHS), the FEMA BRIC Program has been shuttered and will no longer exist in its
31	current form; and

33	WHEREAS, in accordance with the DHS/FEMA guidance, all projects not yet awarded
34	from FY2020 through FY2023 will not be awarded.
35	
36	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska,
37	acknowledges the FEMA BRIC grant application for up to \$500,000 to adopt and implement
38	the 2021 edition of the International Building Code has been canceled.
39	
40	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the city staff will not continue to pursue the adoption
41	and implementation of building codes unless directed by the City Council.
