15	WHEREAS, The Coast Guard leases berth space on the West side of the Pioneer Dock to
16	moor their vessel, the USCG C Aspen Buoy Tender ; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, As part of their priority use agreement for the USCG C Aspen Buoy Tender
19	berth space, a portion of funds, paid monthly by the Coast Guard, is set aside for use in the
20	event of any required maintenance or repairs; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, The Homer City Council adopted Ordinance 23-19 establishing a dedicated
23	reserve for required maintenance or repairs of the USCGE <u>Buoy Tender</u> berth space.
24	·
25	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:
26	
27	Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends the FY26 Capital Budget by
28	appropriating \$20,000 from the USCG€ Buoy Tender Berth Space Maintenance Reserve for
29	anticipated repairs or maintenance of the USCGE berth space as follows:

35	Section 2. This is an annual appropriation and will lapse at the end of the fiscal year.
