DESCRIPTION	The Load and Launch Ramp area has had stormwater issues since 2017 that result in standing water and the recurring formation of a large pothole that poses a risk to trailers. A drywell is a tested solution for drainage problems on the Homer Spit that will allow water to drain properly and eliminate the need for ongoing repaving. The restroom facility at the Load and Launch Ramp is in need of retrofitting to reduce heat loss in the colder winter months due to air leaks, insufficient insulation, and an aged furnace. Revenues from Load and Launch Ramp Fees are dedicated to the operations, maintenance, and replacement of the Load and Launch Ramp area. The recommended improvements will improve energy efficiency and reduce long term operations and maintenance expenses for the Load and Launch Ramp.
