THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO ALLOCATE  
FUNDS TO UPGRADE THE FOOTBALL FIELD AT HOMER

WHEREAS The Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly has placed the upgrading of the  
Homer High School football field to artificial turf on their CIP list as a Tier 1 project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, urges  
the Alaska State Legislature to allocate funds to upgrade the football field at Homer High School  
to artificial turf.
