1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 HOMER, ALASKA Aderhold 3 4 **RESOLUTION 25-086** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE OF HOMER, ALASKA COMMENDING THE 7 ALASKA MUNICIPAL LEAGUE ON ITS 75TH ANNIVERSARY AND 8 RECOGNIZING THE IMPACT OF ITS "STRONGER AT 75" CAMPAIGN 9 TO CELEBRATE AND STRENGTHEN LOCAL GOVERNMENT 10 WHEREAS, The Alaska Municipal League (AML) was founded in 1950 as the League of 11 12 Alaskan Cities and, in 1962, expanded to represent both cities and boroughs, now 13 encompassing 165 municipalities and over 97% of Alaska's population; and 14 15 WHEREAS, AML has been a steadfast advocate for local self-government, playing a key 16 role during the Alaska Constitutional Convention of 1955–56 in the adoption of Article X, which enshrined the principle of maximum local self-government and established Alaska's unique 17 borough system; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, AML has established lasting institutional support for local governments, including the Alaska Municipal League Joint Insurance Association (AMLJIA), the Alaska 21 Municipal Bond Bank Authority, and shared services programs that promote fiscal 22 23 sustainability and risk management; and 24 25 WHEREAS, AML provides essential resources to local governments through training, technical assistance, legislative advocacy, and convening opportunities such as the annual 26 AML Local Government Conference and Newly Elected Officials training, helping local leaders 27 navigate governance challenges with knowledge and confidence; and 28 29 WHEREAS, AML has demonstrated responsive leadership in times of statewide crisis— 30 serving as a vital communication and coordination hub for municipalities during emergencies 31 32 such as the COVID-19 pandemic and ongoing infrastructure and climate resilience efforts; and 33 34 WHEREAS, AML launched its Stronger at 75 campaign in 2025 to commemorate its 75th anniversary, celebrating the League's history, elevating the voices of municipal leaders, and 35 reaffirming its foundational values of community-driven governance, cooperation, and 36 37 progress; and 38 39 WHEREAS, Through storytelling, historical retrospectives, member spotlights, media 40 engagement, and public education, the Stronger at 75 campaign has highlighted AML's legacy 41 and generated renewed momentum toward strengthening Alaska's cities and boroughs for the
