RESOLUTION 25-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
ACKNOWLEDGING THE RESULTS OF THE INVITATION TO BID FOR
CITY OWNED COLD STORAGE 2026 SEASONAL RENTAL UNITS.

10 WHEREAS, In accordance with the Procurement Policy an Invitation to Bid for the City
11 owned Cold Storage Rental Units was advertised in the Homer News on September 25th, 2025,
12 and October 2nd, 2025, submitted to three plans rooms in the state, and posted on the City of
13 Homer website; and

15 WHEREAS, There are eight 8'x10' units and one 22'x10' unit located at the City Ice Plant
16 on the Fish Dock, sealed bids included a completed cold storage unit agreement, and were due
17 on Thursday, October 30th, 2025; and

19 WHEREAS, The season shall start no later than March 15th and end as early as October
20 20th and no later than November 5th; and

22 WHEREAS, Thirty-one bids were received and either met or exceeded the minimum
23 required bid, the winning bidders and amounts in the Invitation to Bid are as follows:

1. Locker #1 to Cory Decook for \$3,300
2. Locker #2 to Cory Decook for \$3,510
3. Locker #3 to The Dragging Anchor for \$3,555
4. Locker #4 to Cory Decook for \$3,400
5. Locker #5 to North Country for \$3,500
6. Locker #6 to Cory Decook for \$3,400
7. Locker #7 to Homer Halibut Hunters for \$3,103
8. Locker #8 to Cory Decook for \$3,510
9. Locker #9 to Cory Decook for \$9,250

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby acknowledges the results of the City Owned Cold Storage Seasonal Rental Units Invitation to Bid for Lockers #1 through #9.
