6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
7 AWARDING THE HIGH MAST LIGHT INSPECTION AND SERVICE
8 PROJECT TO CRESCENT ELECTRIC SUPPLY COMPANY

10 WHEREAS, The City of Homer FY26 Capital Budget includes the High Mast Light
11 Inspection and Service Project for the Port and Harbor, approved by Ordinance 25-39(S)(A);
12 and
13

14 WHEREAS, City Council adopted Ordinance 25-60, amending the FY26 Capital Budget to
15 appropriate an additional \$25,000 from the Port Reserves Fund to fully fund the High Mast Light
16 Inspection and Service project; and

18 WHEREAS, The total approved funding for the High Mast Light Inspection and Service
19 project in the FY26 Capital Budget, and the supplemental appropriation from the Port Reserves
20 Fund is now \$75,000; and

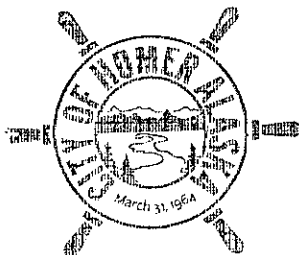
22 WHEREAS, The project is necessary to maintain the safety, reliability, and long-term service life
23 of the high mast lighting system serving the Homer Harbor, Fish Dock, and Pioneer Dock, which
24 consists of poles up to 150 feet in height and is approximately 38 years old; and

26 WHEREAS, The Port and Harbor received quotes from the two qualified Alaska firms
27 capable of performing this specialized work, and Crescent Electric Supply Company, the
28 original supplier of the high mast lighting system, submitted the lowest responsive and
29 responsible bid and possesses the required expertise and experience; and

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby
32 awards the inspection and service project for the High Mast Lights to Crescent Electric.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute
35 the appropriate documents for the project in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.
