1 CITY OF HOMER 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 Burgess **RESOLUTION 13-099** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ENCOURAGING GOVERNOR 6 PARNELL AND THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO INVEST IN 7 TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE. 8 9 WHEREAS, A strong transportation network is vital to Alaska's economy; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Communities across the State of Alaska have outstanding land, air and water 12 transportation needs; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Due to changes in MAP-21, funding for non-National Highway System (NHS) 15 roads has been significantly reduced; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The City of Homer is concerned that insufficient resources are being dedicated 18 to the repair, replacement and upgrade of transportation modes; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Examples of transportation needs in and around the community of Homer 21 include: 22 23 Expansion of the Deep Water Dock to facilitate containerized freight, cruise ship 24 traffic, and resource development industry support 25 Homer Harbor maintenance and expansion projects to stimulate the local economy 26 East to West Transportation Corridor through the core of Homer to improve the flow 27 of traffic and open new land to development 28 Rehabilitation of Lake Street and Pioneer Avenue to maintain the main traffic routes 29 in Homer 30 Sterling Highway Realignment MP 150-157 to protect the only road out of Homer from 31 impending erosion 32 Sterling Highway Reconstruction Anchor Point to Baycrest Hill to address safety issues 33 on this heavily trafficked highway 34 Maintenance and support of the Alaska Marine Highway System, including vessel 35 replacement, to ensure coastal communities link to vital goods and services; 36 37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer, Alaska, that the City of 38 Homer encourages the following efforts by Governor Parnell and the Alaska State Legislature to 39 invest in transportation: 40 41 Increased funding for the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities 42 Funding for individual transportation projects in the FY2015 Capital Budget 43 Continued funding for the Harbor Facility Grant Program 44
