1 CITY OF HOMER 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 City Manager/Lewis/Zak 4 **RESOLUTION 14-035** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, SUPPORTING HOMER HOCKEY ASSOCIATION'S (AKA HOMER 7 8 ICE RINK) EFFORTS TO SECURE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE 9 OF THE EXISTING ICE RINK FACILITIES. 10 WHEREAS, An ice rink is an important source of all-weather winter recreation for the 11 city of Homer, Alaska, and surrounding areas, including Ninilchik, Anchor Point, Nikolaevsk, 12 Kachemak Selo, and other Kenai Peninsula communities; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Homer's ice rink serves as a wholesome source of competition and exercise 15 16 for individuals of all ages; and 17 WHEREAS, Activities at Homer's ice rink foster sportsmanship, a sense of fair play, and 18 19 a sense of community; and 20 WHEREAS, The current facility, built in 2005, is heavily used by the community with 21 weekly visits in excess of 800 persons; and 22 23 WHEREAS, In 2013/14, the Homer ice rink has been the site of 72 youth games, 16 out-24 of-town team practices, 3 jamboree tournaments, and 11 high school games, all of which 25 26 attract winter visitors to Homer; and 27 WHEREAS, The Homer Ice Rink has been operated successfully as the Homer Hockey 28 Association non-profit 501(c)(3) since 1996; and 29 30 WHEREAS, The Homer rink is the only non-profit run rink in Alaska and one of only four 31 in the United States; and 32 33 WHEREAS, The coaches, managers, Board of Directors, and other members of HHA 34 have contributed 14,000 volunteer hours in the 2013-14 season; and 35 36 WHEREAS, The Homer Hockey Association has successfully operated the rink and its 37 programs for over nine years; and 38

WHEREAS, One of the reasons for this success was the requirement of repayment of only the interest on the loan used to finance construction of the rink; and WHEREAS, In the Fall of 2015, Homer Hockey Association will be required to make payments on the loan principle, more than doubling monthly expenses on the rink; and WHEREAS, These additional financial burdens will make rink operations fiscally impossible. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council supports efforts by Homer Hockey Association members and supporters to secure funding to purchase the rink, free the Homer Hockey Association from the building debt burden, and thus guarantee the future of the tremendous community asset that is the Homer Ice Rink.
